Gospel Meditation Jesus Feeds the Five Thousand & Jesus Walks on Water Mark 6:30-52

- 1. The event of the feeding takes place around April of 29 AD, near the Sea of Galilee, and occurs when the apostles return from their missionary work.
- 2. Hoping to be alone with His disciples, Jesus moves to a desolate place. However, the crowds who are so attracted to His words and miracles show up and prevent resting for Jesus and His apostles.
- 3. Jesus has compassion on the crowds, despite the difficulties, and continues to teach them. As the day is ending, the apostles advise Jesus to send the people away, as they will need to eat soon. Jesus says, "You give them something to eat," which they cannot do, but He can.
- 4. Jesus finds that there are available five loaves of bread and two fish, hardly enough food for a small family. Jesus now does something incredible. He wants the people to group into fifties and hundreds, then takes the bread and fish, says a blessing, and distributes the food. At the conclusion of the meal, He has His twelve apostles collect what food is left over, and this fills each of the baskets they are carrying, twelve in all, one for each of the apostles.
- 5. At this point, Jesus asks His disciples to get back in the boat and cross the tip of the Sea of Galilee to Bethsaida, while Jesus goes up into a mountain to pray.
- 6. The twelve in the boat encounter a windstorm sometime between 3am and 6am, and then they spot Jesus walking on the sea. They are completely shocked at this. They yell at Him, scared to death, and Jesus merely speaks to them saying, "Take heart, it is I. Do not be afraid." Then He gets into the boat with them.
- 7. Mark's report of the reaction of the twelve is that they were astounded, did not understand this event at all, and their "hearts were hardened."
